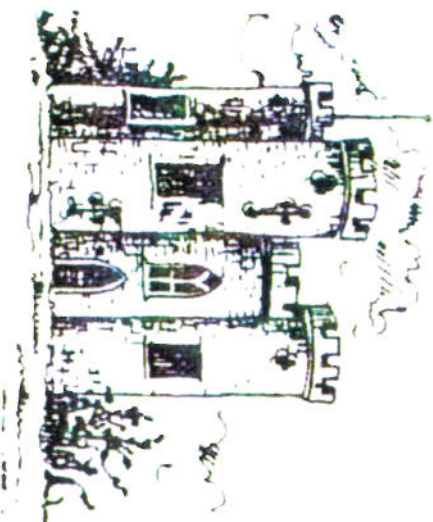

Two excellent cricket pitches, a running club and an orienteering course.

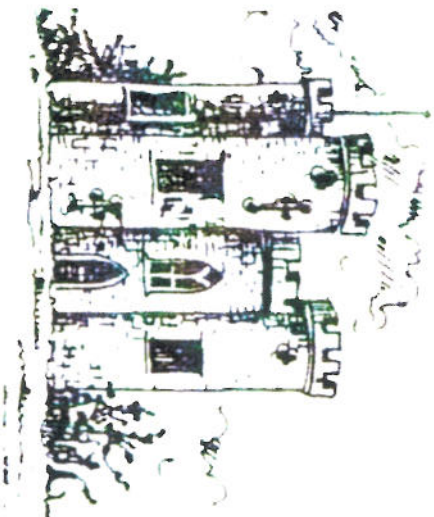
For everybody
