Surprisingly few in Bristol are aware of this large expanse of woodland and parkland in their city, and the many delights it offers.

It boasts a magnificent gorge, massive 200 year old trees, lakes, streams with historical and geological curiosities around every corner.

It is home to the Blaise House Museum, one of the largest play areas in the city, a café and free parking.

There is a working community kitchen garden, rose garden and dairy garden designed by John Nash.

Plenty of open space allows full reign for football, running, dog walking and picnics, all overlooked by the great Castle Folly on the hill, opened up to the public by volunteers during the summer.

Achievements

Some of our achievements

- Helped save the castle from demolition with funding for repair work, a new spiral staircase and display boards.
- Organised volunteer conservation activities throughout the estate.
- Open the Castle, Dairy Garden and Kitchen Garden to the public over the summer months.
- Financed the construction of railings at Lover's Leap, the South Bastion and the Dairy Garden.
- Provided funding for extra benches, bins and new notice boards around the estate.
- In conjunction with the local Henbury community, brought the Kitchen Garden back to life.
- Improved access, including gates and steps at entry points and within the estate.
- Set up a tree trail between the car park and museum.
- Funded a display of plants and repair work to the structure of the Orangery.
- Purchased a new chandelier in the Picture Room of the museum.
- Funded the rethatching of the Dairy Roof.
